The Lab is committed to conducting work efficiently and in a manner that ensures protection of our workers, the public and the environment. This includes work that is done by PPPL staff at off-site locations.

Work activities performed at off-site locations (e.g., collaborations at DIII-D or C-MOD for the installation and operation of hardware) are usually not covered by PPPL procedures. Instead, the host facility's policies and procedures govern off-site activities. If a Lab staff member feels that a host facility's ES&H procedures or controls do not provide for adequate protection of workers, safety or the environment, he/she should not participate in the affected activities until the issues are resolved. Lab staff should tactfully refrain from performing any actions that he/she considers are unsafe or harmful to workers, the environment or the public. If such circumstances are encountered and can not readily be remedied, PPPL workers should notify their PPPL supervisors as soon as possible so that appropriate resolution with the host facility can be achieved. Under no circumstances should a PPPL staff member feel obligated to perform or direct any actions that involve what he or she perceives to be unacceptable risk to workers, the public or the environment.
