- **Review scientific issues in burning plasmas and address the relation of burning plasma in tokamaks to innovative MFE confinement concepts and the relation of ignition in IFE to integrated research facilities.**
- **For MFE: Carry out a “...critical discussion and review of proposed burning plasma experiments and assess the scientific and technological research opportunities and prospective benefits of these approaches to the study of burning plasmas.”**
- **For IFE: Present plans for prospective integrated research facilities, assess present status of the technical base for each, and establish a timetable and technical progress necessary to proceed for each.**
